




# Get Your Home SUMMER-READY!

Taking a few simple DIY steps now will keep you safe and cool all season long.



## Gutters and discharge lines

Repair and clean your gutters, and discharge lines as needed. Flush out your discharge line from the curb end by running a garden hose as far as you can up the line and letting water flush out the line until it runs clear.




## Battery Back-Up

If you have a battery backup system for your sump pump check to see the battery is holding a charge. If you have been putting off replacing the battery, just do it.


## Downspouts

Starting with the downspout nearest the street, test your downspouts and with a garden hose.



## Sump Pump

Clean out the sump pit and make sure the system is pumping to the curb by pouring four or five five-gallon buckets worth of water into the sump pit. If you have a basement waterproofing system that has cleanouts, run a hose in it for a few minutes and make sure it freely flows to the sump pump pit.



## Dehumidifier

Clean and test the condensate pump, drainage basin, and filter of your Dehumidifier.
